Year 8 & 9 - Zoolab Visit

Dear Parent/Carer

In Geography, either last year or this year depending on your child's Year Group, students study the topic Planet Earth. This unit of work concentrates on a variety of ecosystems, the role of plants and animals and the way in which humans interact with these ecosystems. This is also a significant topic for GCSE Geography so if your child is in Year 9, it may help inform their option decision-making.

As part of studying this topic, we have invited a company called Zoolab to come in and do a presentation on the animals of the tropical rainforest and the impact humans have on this ecosystem. They will bring with them a collection of Rainforest animals which students will have the opportunity to see and interact with. The talk will last for 45 minutes and will take place during normal school lesson times.

Cost

Zoolab are an organisation with 20 years of experience and the number one company in the UK for ethical animal encounters. The cost of hosting them at our school over a two-day period is £7.63 per pupil.
